In consideration of Capital Power Corporation and its affiliates ("Capital Power") allowing me to enter onto their wilderness properties ("Wilderness Property") for the purpose of hunting wildlife (the "Activity"), and in consideration of Capital Power, Alberta Hunter Education Instructors' Association (AHEIA), Alberta Professional Outfitters Society (APOS) and Hunting for Tomorrow (HFT) organizing the Activity, I hereby agree as follows:

I acknowledge that the Activity is potentially a **very hazardous activity**:

I fully acknowledge that Capital Power, Alberta Hunter Education Instructors' Association (AHEIA), or Hunting for Tomorrow (HFT) have not made any representations, warranties or assurances, whether written or verbal, express or implied, about the Activity, the physical conditions or suitability of the Wilderness Property for the Activity, or my personal safety or security while engaging in the Activity.

I agree that I am responsible for my own personal safety and security and the safety and security of others while on the Wilderness Property. I agree to take all reasonable and prudent precautions to ensure my own personal safety and to decrease the risk of injury, death, or property damage to any other parties that might coincidentally be on the Wilderness Property.

I hereby voluntarily assume any and all risks associated with the Activity on the Wilderness Property, including, without limitation, bodily injury, death and property damage, all such risks being known and appreciated by me.

I hereby, for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, waive and release Capital Power, Alberta Hunter Education Instructors' Association (AHEIA), Alberta Professional Outfitters Society (APOS) and Hunting for Tomorrow (HFT) and their respective directors, officers, volunteers and employees from any and all liability, suits, actions, claims, causes of action, demands, damages, penalties, judicial or administrative proceedings, fines, costs, and expenses of whatsoever kind and character (including, but not limited to, investigative and legal defense costs) associated with, arising out of or in consequence of any loss, injury or damage, including, without limitation, bodily injury or death, whether foreseeable or not, whether direct or indirect, related in any way to the Activity due to any cause whatsoever, including, without limitation, negligence.

3. An updated Map is included in your package.
4. I have enclosed a copy of the necessary Hunt Report that you are required to file after your hunt. This information is essential to us and is part of the reporting that we provide to Capital Power. **Please send in your reports promptly.** At month's end if we have to contact you for these reports, our reporting process is delayed, which could jeopardize this program. (Please keep in mind that we have 10 of these kinds of programs taking place across the Province.)
5. Best of luck with your hunting season! We hope that you have a great experience and success during your hunts on the Capital Power property.

1. **Site:** CAPITAL POWER —Genesee Power Generating Station
2. **Location:** West of Edmonton — designated areas on CAPITAL POWER property (south of Highway 16 on Secondary Road 770)
3. **WMU:** 334
4. **Partners:** CAPITAL POWER
5. **Dates:** September 2025 to November 2025
6. **Equipment that may be used:**
Bow and Arrow (Archery or General Season)
Crossbow, Black Powder Rifle, and Shotgun with Slugs (November only)
7. **Species eligible to be hunted under this program:** Consult 2025 Hunting Regulations for this WMU
8. **HFT Contact Person:** Allan Orr 780.466.6682

Important Notes

1. Whitetail deer, mule deer (check 2025 Hunting Regulations), elk, moose (draw only) may be harvested on Capital Power property.
2. Animals may be field dressed on the designated hunting areas. Animals may be retrieved by foot access or by motorized conveyance by permission only from Capital Power Security. **If motorized access is required to assist with retrieval, please contact the Security Office at 780-969-8505.**
3. Keep in mind that the majority of the property that HFT is authorized to hunt on is under some form of lease agreement with a farmer (either for crop or pasture). Be aware that you may encounter these lessees; please be courteous and informative. If they have any questions or concerns, please obtain their name and phone number and HFT will follow up.
4. All participants/must display the approved HFT Outdoor Bound Parking Pass on their vehicle windshield.
5. Full details of mentorship program members intending to hunt Genesee lands (including vehicle details) will be kept in a master binder in the Genesee Main Gate Security Building. Security will make cross-references to the master participant list to verify program eligibility.
6. The assigned guard will **actively** patrol all Genesee lands continuously, both to show a security presence to participants and deter infiltration by non-members wishing to trespass or conduct hunting activities of their own outside of this program (including on non-dedicated lands). Please bear in mind Capital Power is not asking security to act as Fish & Wildlife Enforcement Officers but to support the Hunting For Tomorrow Program and existing enforcement activity (eyes and ears).
7. Patrolling should not interfere with the hunting process.
8. Hunting participants will be expected to park at field entrances.
9. **Waterfowl Hunters: Hunt only in designated areas shown on attached access map. No hunting permitted over standing crops. Vehicle access is not permitted, foot access only including setting decoys and blinds.**
10. Pheasant Release Site Registration go to: www.huntingfortomorrow.ca
11. **When you harvest an animal A HUNT REPORT is required to be completed and submitted to Hunting For Tomorrow (AHEIA). This information provides valuable data, that is used to support the program's validity and serves as a positive communication tool within the larger community.**

Important Message From Capital Power

Again this year we have partnered with Hunting for Tomorrow to assist us with our hunting program on Capital Power lands around Genesee. We are allowing the public to access our lands to hunt under the terms and conditions that we have developed with Hunting for Tomorrow.

High powered rifles are not permitted. Bow hunting, Black powder rifles and Shotguns with slugs are allowed. The Provincial Hunting regulations shall apply in all situations.

Important General Information:

1. To participate in this program, all individuals must complete and return the APPLICATION FORM. No one is eligible or approved to participate until these forms are returned and processed by HFT.
2. **When a participant is hunting on the property, please use consideration upon entering or leaving your stand or retrieving an animal to ensure that you do not negatively impact someone else's hunt.**
3. Smoking is prohibited on all properties that we will be hunting.
4. Approved access to these locations is based on the detailed vehicle information that you supply to HFT, which is then sent to all locations. This information is shared with Security, RCMP, Fish and Wildlife and staff. When the areas are patrolled, security will be checking that any vehicles parked in these areas are on the approved list. They will also be checking for your 2025 Harvest Program pass that needs to be displayed in your vehicle window. Please do not take an unauthorized vehicle to the site.
5. Report any unusual vehicles or the presence of unauthorized people. We are considered a valuable resource for "eyes and ears" and the feedback that we provide to security is very important. The Report A Poacher number is 1-800-642-3800. Try to provide the following:

Generating Station****Authorized Equipment**

Hunters must use an authorized bow and an authorized arrow. An authorized bow has a draw weight of no less than 16 kg (35 lbs), draws an arrow of 71 cm (28 in) to its head, and is held, drawn and released by muscle power. An authorized arrow is one that is no less than 61 cm (24 in) in length having a sharp, unbarbed, broad-head of not less than 2.2 cm (7/8 in) in width.

The use of a crossbow, black powder rifle, or shotgun with slugs is permitted during the designated seasons.

Tree Stands and Blinds

Only portable tree stands or ground blinds are permitted. These will be removed at the end of the hunting season.

Passes, Licenses, and Tags

Each hunter must carry the license and applicable tag(s) on their person while hunting. Passes, licenses, and corresponding mentor passes must be produced for inspection upon request by the Security or law enforcement personnel.

Success and Reports

When a big game animal is harvested, HFT should be notified within 12 hours. Hunters will provide the following information: name, description of the wildlife, date, gender, and time of kill. ATV vehicles, with required license and insurance, may be used in accordance with provincial regulations to remove the animal (where authorized to do so). Contact the Security Office (780-969-8505). **This information may be emailed or phoned into HFT. The preferred FORM is attached for your use. Photos are very much encouraged and appreciated.**

Thank you for agreeing to participate in this program. We hope that you receive considerable enjoyment and satisfaction from introducing your passion for hunting and wildlife to someone new or learning about hunting and conservation from an experienced individual. Good luck and straight shooting!

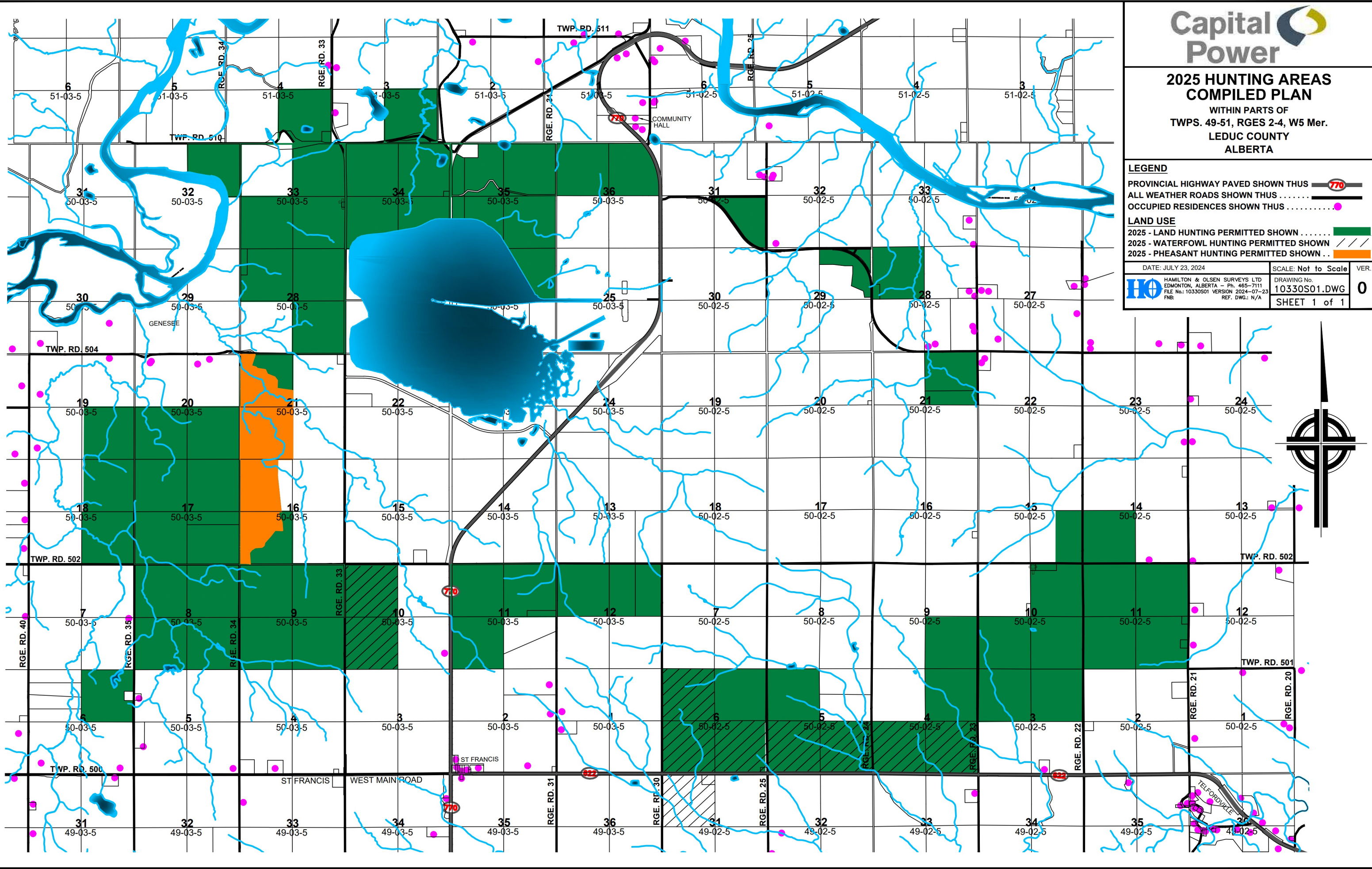
